Reference: Request for a meeting ASAP, Request that you open an official independent investigation

Councilpersons Ozuna, Medina and Soules;

We are requesting that each of you set aside time to meet with members of CAPCWFA as soon as possible. We are requesting that you open an official independent investigation into the criminal activity we continue to report. We are requesting that you lift the illegal ban and allow ALL citizens to attend public Council meetings.

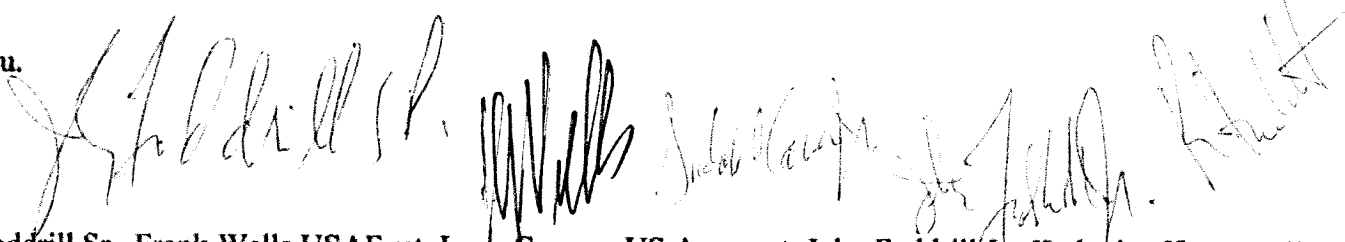
We would like to discuss several issues that impact citizens of ALL Council Districts including but not limited to:

- 1. Texas Open Meetings Violations – In an effort to hide an ongoing criminal cover-up of long term public/police corruption City Attorney Michael Bernard (brother of White House Social Secretary Jeremy Bernard) and Police Chief William McManus issued an illegal/unconstitutional criminal trespass warning on July 1, 2009 in violation of the TOMA and other laws. They refuse to provide a reason, time limit, public hearing or an alternate avenue to participate in OUR City government process. Their actions violate many laws, the City Charter, the Local Government Code and the TOMA. Thirty months of Council meetings are illegal and ALL city business is voidable under the law.**
- 2. Actions of City Attorney Bernard and staff - City Attorney Michael Bernard issued instructions for City persons to ignore reports of criminal activity including theft of public funds from ALL citizens. Former Councilman John Clamp received an email from Bernard and turned citizens away from his Council office. City Attorney Michael Bernard is violating provisions of the City Charter that state that he is**

duty-bound to prohibit the expenditure of OUR tax dollars that was not approved by voters via the Council/city ordinance. He refuses to perform his duty and enlists others to assist him in this endeavor.City Charter - Sec. 142. Limitation on debts incurred. Any debt hereafter contracted by any officer of the city, or by any person on account of the city, the payment of which has not been previously provided for by ordinance duly adopted by the council, shall be absolutely null and void and uncollectible at law or in equity, and it shall be the duty of the city attorney to plead this provision to defeat the collection or enforcement of any such claim or debt

3. Actions of Police Chief McManus and staff- Police Chief William McManus and SAPD have ignored several police reports detailing criminal activity and crimes against citizens of San Antonio. McManus and his staff ignore ALL reports from ALL citizens in an effort to assist other corrupt city persons to hide the crimes.
4. "Fraud upon the Court", Aggravated Perjury, Subornation of Perjury, Obstruction, etc. by City officials/employees/attorneys - In February 2009 inside the Bexar County Courthouse – 57th District Court- City Attorney Deborah Klein conspired with IT Director Hugh Miller and others to defraud our judicial system and hide decades of fraud/theft inside the City's IT Department. SAPD and other law enforcement agencies ignore police reports and correspondence from numerous citizens in an effort to keep the crimes hidden. Criminals involved in the fraud/theft and ongoing cover-up remain on OUR City payroll with access to OUR money, contracts and other resources.
5. Bond and Grant Fraud – City persons have submitted fraudulent audits and other documents in an effort to hide three decades of theft/fraud and the ongoing criminal cover-up of the criminal activity. They submitted false information to Federal investigators concerning HUD-OIG case # HL-10-0465 in an effort to hide massive fraud/theft. City persons stated that only \$648 was misspent when in fact tens of millions of dollars was stolen or misappropriated over the past three decades. Bond offering statements contain known false information and deliberately omit material facts in an effort to conceal criminal activity and the ongoing illegal cover-up.
6. Acts of Councilman Diego M Bernal – Bernal was made aware of the criminal activity in June 2011. Instead of taking action he communicated with others who made terroristic threats against citizens of San Antonio in an effort to hide the corruption and Bernal's participation in the criminal cover-up. Bernal refuses to take steps to protect these citizens and allows SAPD/McManus to ignore official police reports and other correspondence concerning the threats. Their inaction puts our children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren in danger.

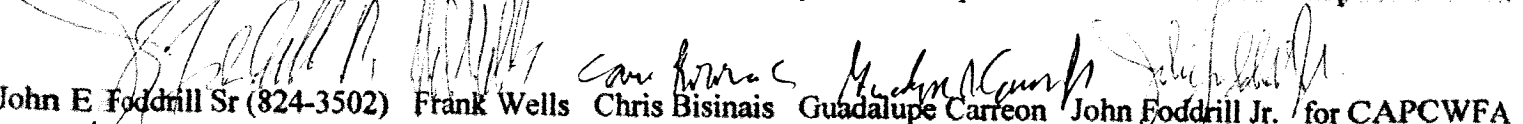

Barthold, Bernal, Medina, Soules and Saldana;

We are resubmitting letters postmarked before all swearing-in ceremonies occurred. We are including documentation showing that corrupt IT managers including IT Director Hugh Miller lied to City Council and illegally steered funds to a "preferred" vendor. The statement submitted supporting the purchase of Cisco equipment for the EOC is false. A competitive bid was on record since 2004 BUT IT Director Miller and other criminals violated the law, lied to Council, published fraudulent reports defaming an incumbent vendor- Avaya, illegally steered funds to a "preferred" vendor, etc. This is not an isolated incident as corrupt ITSD employees illegally spent up to \$ 5.2 million a year via the telephone "variable" billing account when they falsified documents/records to gain illegal access to city telephone budgets. They used the funds for other than their intended purpose. They spent the money with no Council approval, no vote, no paperwork approved by Finance/Budget/City Manager/etc, no audit, no public review, etc. They then lied under oath with the assistance of City Attorneys Deborah Klein, Michael Bernard and others.

Recent news articles describe how DPS-SAA employees and contractors illegally "steered" funds to "preferred" vendors and circumvented the competitive bidding laws put in place to protect our tax dollars. The criminals were terminated, the Agency was "gutted" and funds were withheld. Instead of following the law and attacking the fraud here in SA our corrupt officials/employees lie, hide the crimes and instruct everyone to ignore the crimes instead.

By law taxpayers are not required to pay for illegal, unauthorized, etc. purchases. Purchases made with no competitive bidding, Council approval, etc. are illegal and demands for payment are unenforceable. City Attorney Bernard, City Manager Sculley, Chief McManus, IT Director Miller, etc. must be investigated and held accountable for their part in the illegal use/theft of our money and the five year cover-up of the crimes financed with public funds.

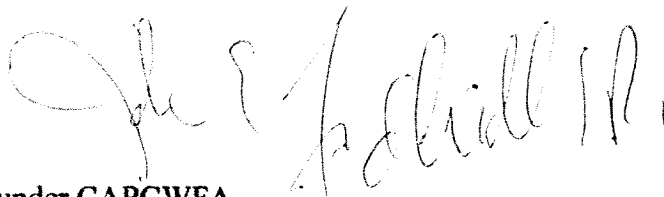
You can obtain a full copy of former CIO Richard Varn's 2007 deposition (When asked about the telephone "variable" billing account Varn stated under oath - "I don't know what that is") , Administrative Directive 6.12, the full set of ADs mandating competitive bidding, public review, ordinances, votes, etc. to obtain funding, the City Charter, the Local Government Code, etc. from staff.

You can obtain a copy of Varn's 2009 courtroom testimony from staff showing that he testified to the court and to our citizens with the illegal assistance of city attorney Deborah Klein that it was legal to wander over to the IT Dept. and pick up as much money as one needed for whatever purpose and that the money would be transferred via the "variable" billing account from every department and grant telecommunications budget. You can obtain copies of the courtroom transcripts of the other city employees who participated in the "fraud upon the court" when they were coached by Klein to present known false, fabricated testimony under oath.

After reviewing this sampling of evidence please arrange a meeting with my group, Bexar County Precinct 3 Constable Mark Vojvodich, the FBI (not the local liars) and forensic auditors outside of the firms having current and past contracts with the City. You may want to inform bond underwriters and the SEC of the fraud, cover-up, fraudulent official statements, financial reports and audits ASAP.

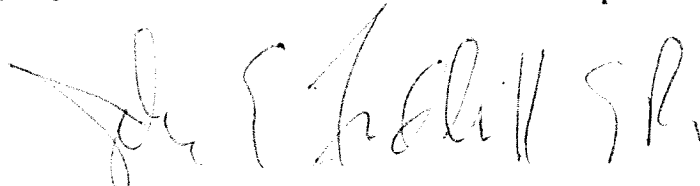
The law, the City Charter, the Texas Local Government Code, the City Code of Ethics, OMB regulations, Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, State Bar Opinions, etc. provide guidance and/or clear-cut instructions concerning such matters. A September 2009 ruling by the State Bar declares that an attorney is prohibited from engaging in conduct that constitutes obstruction of justice:

It should be noted that, if, by failing to report criminal activity of an adverse party or witness, the lawyer is himself committing a serious criminal act or obstructing justice, then Rule 8.04(a)(2) and (4) would be implicated. A lawyer violates Rule 8.04(a) (2) if the lawyer commits "a serious crime" or "any other criminal act that reflects adversely on the lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer in other respects" Rule 8.04(a) (4) prohibits a lawyer from engaging in conduct that constitutes obstruction of justice. -THE PROFESSIONAL ETHICS COMMITTEE FOR THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS Opinion No. 589

Citizens and I provided you with numerous reports of the criminal activity beginning in June 2011 and requested your assistance. We asked that you follow the Texas Open Meeting Act and help us lift the criminal trespass warning issued on July 1, 2009 (two years BEFORE your election) with no reason, time limit or due process hearing. It is our opinions that instead of following the law, the Rules, the City Code of Ethics, OMB regulations, the City Charter, the TOMA, etc. you made a deliberate decision to ban me from your Facebook page on Sept. 19, 2011 for no reason other than to stop reports of the crimes being made public, to delete your entire Facebook account (Diego M Bernal) to hide our reports of the crimes to you and to assist other City persons in their efforts to hide the criminal activity.

Judge Antonia Arteaga along with attorneys Malinda Gaul, Dave Willborn, Kathleen Cassidy Goodman and Edward Pina have proof of the theft/misuse of public/grant funds, the "fraud upon the court" of Feb 2009, the unconstitutional criminal trespass warning, the ongoing criminal conspiracy to conceal the crimes, etc. Your actions and the actions of these judges/attorneys are governed by laws, regulations, Codes and Rules declaring that participation in the ongoing criminal conspiracy is prohibited. Ref: Overview of Public Corruption, Theft, Fraud, Misapplication of dedicated funds and cover-up

The attached page details excerpts from documents submitted to law enforcement including references to many illegal, unauthorized expenditures of public funds that are NOT the responsibility of taxpayers per the law. The examples are but a small part of the illegal misuse of up to \$100 million since 1982:

1. Attorney Mark Kosanovich was hired by corrupt City officials to assist City Attorney Deborah Klein, IT Director Hugh Miller, former CIO Richard J H Varn and others suborn perjury, obstruct justice and present a "fraud upon our Court" when they conspired to hide decades of criminal activity - \$ 50,000
2. City IT Manager Jose Medina and long-time City vendor Isabel Gonzaba (IG Communications) conspired to submit and approve known fraudulent invoices that were processed in other states (Mail/wire fraud). Up to \$200,000 was stolen over a four year time frame when up to six fraudulent submissions a month were made.
3. Former CIO Richard J H Varn, City Attorney Deborah Klein, IT Director Hugh Miller, Attorney Mark Kosanovich and others presented a "fraud upon the Court" in February 2009 -2006CI06702 - and offered fabricated testimony to hide decades of criminal activity and the ongoing illegal cover-up of the crimes.
4. IT Network Manager Michael Mitchell illegally submitted an invoice for over \$310,000 to be paid from city/grant funds set aside by law for telecommunications support by disguising the payment as a monthly Centrex phone expense processed via AD 6.12 and the monthly telephone variable billing account.
5. Former IT Manager Victor Perez approves the use of illegal contractors (no contract, no bidding, no Council approval, no ordinance) and the illegal payments (over \$50,000 including a \$10,000 markup) are illegally, secretly processed as monthly phone costs.
6. City Officials including Budget Director Peter Zanoni, IT Director Hugh Miller and former CIO Michael Armstrong are notified by former Municipal Integrity manager Virginia Quinn that she closed an official investigation with a "lack of evidence/unfounded" finding BUT actually found decades of misuse of public funds affecting every City department (untold amounts of goods and services- 25 years) .

City Attorney Michael Bernard, City Manager Sheryl Sculley, Police Chief William McManus, IT Director Hugh Miller, former CIO Richard J H Varn, former CIO Michael Armstrong, City Attorney Deborah Klein, attorney Mark Kosanovich and others etc. have conspired for the past five years to hide these and other violations of law, have induced others to violate the law and have hindered the recovery of our pilfered funds.

You can join the conspiracy to hide the RICO-like criminal activity or you can immediately contact law enforcement.

Voluntary Statement of John E. Foddrill Sr.

STATE OF TEXAS, COUNTY OF BEXAR

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for the State and County aforesaid, on this day, personally appeared John E. Foddrill Sr., being by me duly sworn upon his oath deposes and says:

My name is John E. Foddrill Sr.; I am 60 years old, born on 6/5/51 in New York, New York. My address is 9650 Limestone Pond, San Antonio, Texas 78254. I am a citizen of the City of San Antonio and the State of Texas. I was employed as the Telecommunications Manager for the City of San Antonio reporting to the Information Technology Systems Department (ITSD). I graduated from Texas Southmost College in 1980. I can read, write, speak and understand the English Language.

I make the following statement.

On or about July 7, 2011, San Antonio Police Department Mental Health Division Sergeant Romana Lopez published a fraudulent report and submitted this report to SAPD Deputy Chief Anthony Muro. (reference 11-167835)

The report concerned the July 4, 2011 - Independence Day - visit by SAPD officers Bandoske and Smarro after 10 pm to citizens at 9650 Limestone Pond and 10403 Blackstone Creek in NW San Antonio, Texas. The officers are assigned to the Mental Health Division and were dispatched to perform a mental health assessment. Citizens inside each home were summoned from their beds by knocks on their front doors by armed policemen with badges hung from their necks and radios broadcasting police traffic. The citizens had violated no laws, caused no disturbances, threatened no one, were not a threat to themselves or anyone else, etc. and were home in bed.

In her report SAPD Sgt. Romana Lopez falsely states "At the time, we did not have a telephone number for Mr. Foddrill." (copy attached)

Documents received via a FOIA request shows that phone number - 824-3502 - is hand-written on an email of July 1, 2011 from Officer Christine Dorsey to Sgt. Lopez. At the bottom of the email that I sent to Gabriel Velasquez of the Avenida Guadalupe Association on June 23, 2011 to report Mayor Castro's hypocritical criticism of the organization's fiscal records I list additional information when I signed my email with "John E. Foddrill Sr. 824-3502", Founder capcwfa. Another email forwarded to the media and SAPD also lists my name, my phone number and two email addresses - foddrill@swbell.net and capcwfa@swbell.net. Numerous documents and emails identified me as the City's former Telecommunications Manager. I also included links to several documents published on the internet including a sworn affidavit submitted to Bexar County Constable Mark Voivodich. I attached a copy of an affidavit detailing numerous crimes committed by City employees. I attached a copy of a CD index that I sent to numerous persons that detail meetings with Senator Jeff Wentworth, Senator Leticia Van De Putte, Asst. DA Barry Elliott, Texas Ranger Hank Whitman, HUD OIG agent Victoria Marquez, etc. The CD index document contained information detailing how Bexar County Constable Mark Voivodich had an open investigation into the allegations, that local FBI agents had provided FOIA replies for document requests and that the Office of Municipal Integrity/City Attorney Bernard had illegally denied FOIA requests. I included reports that describe how City Attorney Michael Bernard issued illegal, unethical instructions to city employees, City Council, the Mayor, law enforcement, etc. to

ignore ALL reports of the crimes and cover-up by ALL citizens and how many citizens were turned away from City offices when they tried to report the criminal activity. The CD index reveals how City Attorney Bernard had issued an illegal, unconstitutional criminal trespass warning on July 1, 2009 barring entry into public Council meetings and City Hall thus violating the Texas Open Meetings Act making twenty-five (25) months of meetings illegal and all business conducted during the illegal meetings voidable. (warning and my photo are posted in public buildings) I included reports that SAPD 9,0471467 and BCSO 2009,081395 were closed out with no action or callback from law enforcement.

My phone number is listed. It is in the phone directory. My Texas driver's license is on record. My address is in the 911 telephone system directory. As the City's former Telecommunications Manager my phone number is contained in City records. Google my name and a wealth of information is revealed.

SAPD Mental Health Division Sgt. Romana Lopez intentionally lied in an official SAPD report. She had my phone number. She also had access to a wealth of information about me that I never tried to hide from anyone.

Sgt. Lopez's fraudulent report containing known false information is yet another example of the efforts by the San Antonio Police Department to justify their continued harassment of me, my family, my neighbors, my associates, etc. in an effort to discredit reports of three decades of criminal activity inside the City and to justify the ongoing five year criminal cover-up of the crimes committed by City employees who themselves violate the law in the process.

This statement is true and correct to the best of my recollection, and I have not been promised anything in return.

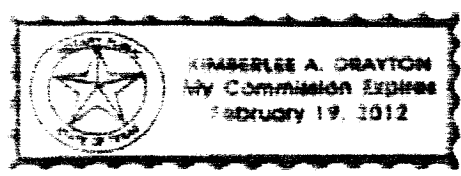

REPORT OF VIOLATIONS OF LAW RELATED TO SAPD 11167835/SAPD-2011-0702097

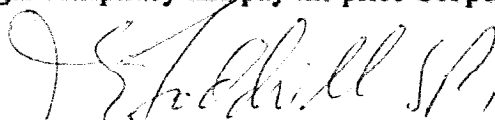
Recent efforts by SAPD and "the City" to discredit my reports and further defame me have failed. Report **SAPD 11167835/SAPD-2011-0702097** published by SAPD Officer Bandoske deems my reports of long-term public/police corruption credible and cites my report of up to \$ 4 million a year in fraud for the past 20-25 years. Corrupt City employees conspired with others to steal, misuse, misappropriate, etc. up to \$ 100 million in telecommunications-E911 funds since 1982 with no Council and taxpayer approval, no vote, no public review, no ordinance, no audit, etc. They hid the fraud by falsely listing the expenses in reports and audits as monthly phone bill payments. Much of the money was used to fuel criminal schemes such as "padded" time report invoices, illegal no-bid contracts steered to friends, "favors", etc. Every City Department and grant was impacted including SAPD and SAFD. The City Charter, the Texas Local Government Code, OMB regulations and other laws declare that taxpayers are NOT responsible for the illegally, fraudulently dispersed funds clandestinely spent without their approval.

City services, public safety personnel and citizens suffered due to the theft/fraud. The crimes impacted the E911 system as funding was not available to repair a failing telephone/911 network that was not properly processing 25 % of calls to 911- funds had been stolen/misused. Recently the 911 system crashed-AGAIN. The liars/thieves at ITSD who have conspired for years to hide criminal activity inside the IT Department and who published fraudulent reports, audits, statements, proposals, etc. are still on the City payroll in charge of the E911 system and associated funding. 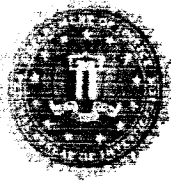

This is in response to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request.

We have located approximately 1,218 pages which are potentially responsive to your request. Pursuant to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) regulations, 28 C.F.R. §§ 16.11 and 16.49, there is a duplication fee of ten cents per page. The first 100 pages will be provided to you free of charge. In accordance with the DOJ regulations, the FBI notifies requesters when anticipated fees exceed \$25. If all of the pages that are potentially responsive to your request are released, you will owe \$111.80 in duplication fees. Although no payment needs to be made at this time, you must notify us in writing within 60 days from the date of this letter of your willingness to pay. Please remember that this is only an estimate, and if some of the pages are withheld in full pursuant to FOIA/Privacy Act exemption(s) or are determined to not be responsive to your request, the actual charges could be less.

A representative of Attorney General Abbott's Office suggested that we contact you.

We filed a Texas Open Meetings Act complaint citing the fact that at least two law-abiding citizens were illegally prohibited from participating in public meetings by San Antonio TX City Attorney Michael Bernard (brother of White House Social Secretary Jeremy Bernard), Mayor Julian Castro (Obama campaign co-chairman) SAPD Chief William McManus and others. U.S. District Judge Rodriguez issued an injunction on March 27, 2013 stating "Defendants are enjoined from enforcing the criminal trespass letter during the pendency of this litigation." Judge Rodriguez cited the fact that the City provided no proof of a physical threat, the lack of due process, the lack of procedural safeguards and a citizen's right to freedom of expression being protected by the First Amendment. In response to the Judge's ruling the City lifted bans of seven months and forty-five months. Both citizens cite their "whistle blowing" as the reason Bernard illegally banned them in an effort to hide criminal activity including the theft and misuse of 911 and other public safety funds.

Bexar County District Attorney Susan Reed ignored the original TOMA complaint of April 25, 2013 and a follow-up letter of May 14, 2013. In an effort to protect her former Assistant DA - now City Attorney Michael Bernard - Reed and her office have ignored reports of public/police corruption, the theft of upwards of \$200,000 by City IT manager Jose Medina and city vendor Isabel Gonzaba, no-bid contracts with huge mark-ups steered to "friends", mail/wire fraud, a "fraud upon the court" financed with public funds by Bernard to hide the criminal activity, aggravated perjury, obstruction, grant fraud, falsification of government documents, bond fraud, abuse of office, accounting fraud and other crimes.

In an effort to protect City Attorney Michael Bernard and others Reed's office has in the past made false statements that they had no jurisdiction when State Senator Leticia Van De Putte and Texas Ranger Hank Whitman indicated otherwise (recording of a meeting with Van De Putte where she reviews the reports of criminal activity and Whitman's letters are available for review). Reed's Office made the false statement that no investigation into the reports of corruption was conducted as there was no evidence of wrongdoing while a published statement to the Attorney General, a search warrant, recordings, etc. indicate that an investigation was in fact begun after ADA Barry Elliott and Texas Ranger Whitman saw proof of the criminal activity - especially the four years of theft via "packaged" invoices by Medina and Gonzaba. The investigation was prematurely halted and participants were sworn to silence to hide the criminal activity.


District Attorney Reed's Office ignored many reports of criminal activity but her failure to take action concerning reports of terroristic threats made by supporters of City Councilman Diego M. Bernal to intimidate/scare whistleblowers put lives at risk. A cursory investigation into the telephone and internet threats would have revealed that the "ringleader" of the group Anonymous/OccupySA whose members communicated with Bernal via middle of the night Facebook texting (documents available) and who then made the threats was registered high-risk sexual predator Eric Michael King - aka Serpentina Kingsley. Families including young children remain at risk while DA Reed and her staff look away.

San Antonio TX FBI Agent D. True Brown published a document falsely stating that three separate meetings took place and no wrongdoing by the City was ever discovered. Since 2009 we have asked the FBI for information concerning the dates, times, participants, etc. in these "ghost" meetings. Sooner or later the FBI and DOJ must concede that Agent Brown was being untruthful, there were no meetings and there is proof of an ongoing criminal conspiracy inside the City of San Antonio and Bexar County Texas. FOIA case # 1206258-000 is still open. We wait for an answer and again request assistance. Please schedule a meeting with a group of citizens to discuss this criminal activity and provide us with an opportunity to submit sworn complaints.

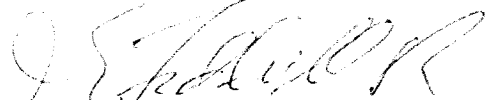


Exhibit 14 – Email of 5/29/2013 – DPS Major Alexis

"You are not to enter or remain on certain city-owned or city-leased property or building. The notice is made pursuant to section 30.05 (criminal trespass) of the Texas Penal Code.

You are prohibited from entering or remaining in San Antonio City Hall...

You are prohibited from entering or remaining in the Municipal Plaza building...

You are prohibited from entering or remaining in that portion of the Public Safety Building occupied by the Information Technology Services Department...

You are prohibited from entering or remaining in that portion of the River View Towers building that is occupied by the offices of the City of San Antonio...

These prohibitions shall remain in effect until you are notified in writing, by someone with authority to act on behalf the City of San Antonio that these prohibitions have been lifted."

During our meeting you informed me that you would withdraw your letter of July 1, 2009 and that the prohibitions would be lifted and that you would send me a letter to this effect in the near future. I still have never received your letter.

This criminal trespass warning has been in effect for twenty two (22) months. If you are renegeing on your promise to withdraw your letter prohibiting Mr. Foddrill from coming upon the City property described in your letter then I need to know this. I will need for you to provide me with copies of any documents or evidence you have relied upon for issuing this criminal trespass warning to Mr. Foddrill.
